HISTORY

The Marques de Casa Concha line was launched in 1976 in honor of the noble title that King Phillip V of Spain conferred on the Concha y Toro family in 1718, making Marques de Casa Concha's limited edition wines an expression of both the Concha y Toro tradition and the art of making wine.

In the 1990s, improvements in vineyard management and winemaking techniques transformed Marques de Casa Concha into a wine that was sought after at the international level, where it earned major international honors to position itself as one of the most solid and consistent brands in its segment.

ORIGIN

Marques de Casa Concha is line produced in Chile that fully encompasses the country's diversity. It is grown in vineyards in which the complex interplay among natural conditions, vineyard planning and the years it has taken for the vines to develop endows the entire line with a unique character.

CONSISTENCY

Marques de Casa Concha has been singled out in the most prestigious wine press, never scoring less than 90 points and becoming over time the most widely recognized Chilean brand in its segment and a leading brand with solid scores at the global level.
